Rules and Regulations: Please take your time and read the following very carefully. If you are unsure about any of the following rules and regulations, no matter how small and insignificant it may seem, please contact us using the e-mail address at the bottom of the page. We will answer all questions you may have.

We reserve the rights to change the rules up to a week before competition; however, no major rules such as time limit will change.

1. Teams will be allowed a minimum of 2:30 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes to complete their routine. This time starts with the team's first organized movement or first note of music and timing will end at the last note of music or when the ending motion or pose is hit. Cheering off and on to the floor does not count as part of routine time. All participants should walk onto the floor and immediately start their routine after placement of any props.

4. All routines will be judged using a 100 point scale. The decisions of the judges are **FINAL**.

5. Please bring **TWO HIGH QUALITY** copies of your music to the event.

6. One representative of your squad / team will be responsible for your music during the competition. This person must remain at the sound area throughout the entire performance.

7. All participants must submit a signed liability waiver form and health form prior to performing. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

8. Jewelry is deemed a **SAFETY HAZARD**, and as such every item of jewelry will cause an infraction on your teams scorecard. When dealing with new piercing studs are acceptable. All other items of jewelry must be taken off.
